The NSERC Canadian FloodNet is an interdisciplinary research network designed to enhance the flood management capacity in Canada. Details on FloodNet research can be found on our website at www.nsercfloodnet.ca. Joining FloodNet can carry many potential benefits including access to recent research, collaboration opportunities and the potential to contribute in a meaningful way to improve Canada's resilience to flooding. There are two potential avenues in which an individual can join FloodNet. Both methods require (i) affiliation with either an academic institution or an organization which are partner of FloodNet or are being considered for partnership; and (ii) approval by FloodNet Project Leaders, Research Management Committee and Board of Directors.

Collaborator – A collaborator is an individual who has expertise related to FloodNet research but whose research is not directly funded by the Network. Collaborators often have externally funded research programs that complement or build upon those that exist within FloodNet and will benefit from their interaction with FloodNet researchers and partners. Collaborators can interact in many ways at the discretion of the leader of the project they wish to join and can include complimentary independent research, serving on student committees, co-supervising students, providing commentary on research findings, etc.

Investigator – An investigator is an individual who is conducting research that is directly funded through FloodNet. Investigators can join an existing project or propose a new project, subject to approval by the FloodNet Research Management Committee and Board of Directors. Approval of new investigators/projects is contingent on available funding and therefore an individual applying to join FloodNet as an investigator may be offered to join as a collaborator depending on the needs/resources of the Network.
